Greetings

We hope you were able to meet Rosemary Morrison, our intended Interim Minister, while she visited us during the past two weeks. We are grateful for her proceeding in good faith that issues will be favorably resolved so she can join us officially this fall. Thank you, Rosemary, for visiting us and volunteering to lead worship services while you were here: *Getting to Know You* on 2 September and *Love is the Water* on 9 September. During her visit here, she met with many congregants and church leaders, went to as many committee meetings as she could fit into her schedule, participated in the church retreat and sang with the Blue Moon Rising community choir. Through it all, Rosemary has been listening, learning and connecting.

Before she can officially join us as our Interim Minister, the following must occur:

- Our congregation's non-profit status must be reinstated. We have applied for reinstatement of our non-profit status and have submitted myriad documents to support our application. Although we are still considered a non-profit organization because we are a member congregation in the Unitarian Universalist Association of Congregations (UUA), our congregation must hold our own 501(c)(3) certificate in order to hire a non-immigrant worker.
- The United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) must conduct a site visit of UUCTC. Scheduling the site visit is apparently one of life's mysteries and we have requested assistance from Senator Joe Donnelly's office.
- UUCTC's Petition to Request a Non-Immigrant Religious Worker must be resubmitted and approved.
- Rosemary Morrison must apply for and receive an R-1 visa.

In the meantime, our congregation has been stepping up to welcome Rosemary Morrison. Thanks to MaryAnn Foley's hospitality, Rosemary was able to stay long enough for us to become acquainted. During the retreat, Mark VanMeeter painted the office which will soon belong to our interim minister. As tenacious as terriers, Jean Herr and Janice Kritchevsky have stayed on the trail, pressing forward to resolve the issues as quickly as we can. We will bring Rosemary on board as our interim minister as quickly as we have the legal standing to do so. In the meantime, please express gratitude to all for the work they are doing to help our congregation to move forward together.

faith-based

organization that has built and renovated more than 800,000 houses worldwide since its foundation in 1976.

Habitat is dedicated to eliminating substandard housing and homelessness worldwide and making adequate, affordable shelter a matter of conscience and action. The organization invites people from all faiths and walks of life to work together in partnership, building houses with low-income families who invest "sweat equity" in their houses. Our local organization serves six counties, and it has completed approximately 300 homes in Greater Lafayette since it opened its doors in 1984. Habitat has the manpower to build 12-15 homes a year for lowincome families locally. You might like to consider participating in a build!







\$356.81 was raised for Wabash Riverkeeper through our weekly Change for Change collection in July and August. Our UU member, Rae Schnapp, is the head of this independent organization that works to protect the Wabash River, the longest un-dammed river east of the Mississippi. Her work emphasizes agricultural impacts on water quality, focuses on watershed awareness through workshops, and sponsors projects such as De-trash the Wabash. - **Bottled Water for volunteers** leave at church by 10/3 or bring to Fort on 10/4 or 10/5


Last year UUCTC fundraising efforts at the Feast


