OWL (Our Whole Lives) is a sexuality education curriculum that equips participants with accurate, ageappropriate information. All OWL facilitators are comprehensively trained through the UUA (Unitarian Universalist Association).

In order for a child to participate in the program, families must attend a mandatory orientation session. At the orientation session, the teaching facilitators will introduce families to the curriculum and philosophy of the program. The orientation is scheduled for January 20<sup>th</sup> from 12:30-1:30pm for prek-2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> graders/families and 1:45-2:45pm for 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> graders/families. Snacks will be provided. Registration deadline is Sunday, January 13<sup>th</sup>. Please note that if your child is a 3<sup>rd</sup> grader, consult the facilitators and/or workshop topics. to determine the best placement for your child. Also note that the schedule is subject to change at the facilitator's discretion and every effort will be made to contact you in the event of a cancellation.
