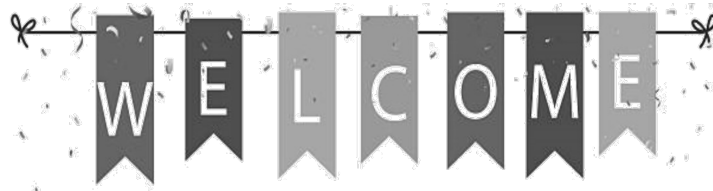
*More Than One Life*

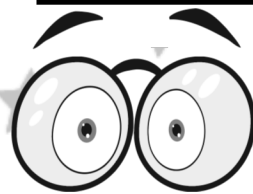
