During September and October, Change for Change raised \$271.32 for Heartford House, a child advocacy center serving Tippecanoe and six surrounding counties. Heartford House strives to protect and advocate for the well-being of abused children by providing a setting where children can be interviewed in a safe, non-threatening environment.

Their primary focus is on child sexual abuse; they have conducted over 8,000 interviews since they began in 2000. The staff work with law enforcement, social and medical services, and the legal system to help children move from being victims to being survivors. Crisis intervention and support services for caregivers of abused children are also part of Heartford House's mission.

For Jubilee, our church and many others in the area adopt families and purchase multiple nice new gifts for the children. Every year, we collaborate with Church of the Brethren, and Friends of Lafayette. This year, the event will take place at 9:30 AM at the Church of the Brethren. Members of the

congregation can contribute through time, talent, or treasure. One way to participate is by buying the toys that parents can select to give as gifts for their children. We have gift tags for each child with their gender and age listed. For each tag, we ask people to buy one nice \$25 to \$35 gift and one \$5 stocking stuffer. For those who would rather contribute with their time, we have many volunteer opportunities. For those who are available on the evening of Friday, December 13, there are opportunities to help with set up and decorating. On Jubilee day, we are in need of

volunteers to host families. This includes helping families shop for toys and wrap them. There is also a need for kitchen volunteers.
