The Ministerial Search Committee, from the Settlement Handbook:

Selecting a Search Committee

The search committee should:

- Represent the entire congregation.
- Be trusted by the congregation.
- Be in touch with the changing nature of the congregation.
- Be responsible for a good process for itself, the congregation, and Unitarian Universalism.

Selecting a Search Committee is the work of both the leadership and the entire congregation. Thile congregational by-laws may indicate a procedure, and while congregations ultimately have the ability to make their own decisions, ministers are more likely to be interested in serving a congregation where the Search Committee is representative, trusted, in touch, and responsible to the entire congregation.

The Search Committee is responsible for putting together the materials that will describe the congregation to ministers seeking a settled position. Committee members review the application packages of minister candidates and aid in introducing them to the congregation. It requires a substantial time commitment but is extremely rewarding.
